

Additional Study Sessions 2018



Dear Parents

I would like to take this opportunity to highlight fully, the additional study programme to both you and your child, and to encourage your son or daughter to take up the excellent opportunities available to them with regards to enrichment, and the new additional study sessions in the build up to their exams later in this academic year.

Stockport School has invested significant time and funding into the development of this programme. The commitment from our teaching staff has been first class in relation to them giving over their own free time to support our students through this programme. In total there are over **189** additional teaching hours spread over **19** separate days, on offer to our students in the programme, making it the most extensive programme we have ever offered.

The following pages of this booklet contain details of the **Additional Study Programme Timetable**, which outlines dates and times for the additional study sessions. The programme incorporates a total of **6 days during the Easter break (Tuesday 3rd April – Wednesday 4th April and Monday 9th April – Thursday 12th April), 6 Saturday & Sunday mornings in April & May, 3 days of the Whit Half Term holiday (Tuesday, 29th May – Thursday 31st May), and finally 4 Saturday & Sunday mornings in June.**

It is important that your son or daughter takes careful note of the attached timetable, and picks up the specific subject lessons on it. You will hopefully note that the timetable contains the subject information, including the name of the teacher who will be delivering the additional study session for that subject (*please note that in some instances it may not always be your child's usual teacher*).

Students who wish to attend are not required to wear school uniform for any of the sessions advertised, but should of course come dressed and equipped appropriate for study. Students must enter and leave via the Mile End Lane gates, and should be registered in class by their subject teachers. In the unlikely event of a fire alarm, staff and students should evacuate the premises as normal and line up on the school playground to be registered. Staff will allow students a short 15 minute break part way through each of the sessions, but no refreshments will be available to purchase on-site during the additional study dates, and students are asked to bring their own snacks and drinks on the dates that they attend.

Students will be reminded in advance by their subject teachers of the study sessions as they occur, and we will endeavour where possible to send out text and e-mail reminders to you as parents to keep you informed.

Attendance at the additional sessions is of course completely voluntary, but we would emphasise the importance where possible in your son or daughter attending the additional sessions in order to benefit their overall learning. In relation to this, there is considerable evidence to suggest that students who attended after-school enrichment sessions and the additional study programme last year went on to perform exceptionally well in their external exams.

We would also obviously ask you as parents to support us by helping to encourage your son or daughter to take up the opportunities on offer to them, both during enrichment and via the additional study programme, so to help maximise their exam performance.
