Mobile Phone Policy

- All mobile phones **MUST** be turned off, and be put away on arrival in the morning at the school gate to leaving the school building at the end of the day.
- Any phones, personal music players and headphones, **SEEN when students enter the school site and during the school day** will be confiscated and parents/carers will be required to come in to school to collect the item.
- They must **NOT** be used for communication of **ANY** type or photography on the school premises including the dining room and the school grounds
- Parents and Carers should not attempt to contact or message students on their mobile phones during the school day. If it is necessary in an emergency for a parent/carer to contact their child during the school day then they should do this by contacting the School Reception/Office who will then pass on the message to the student during the day.
- School cannot be responsible for the security of mobile phones or personal music players.
- During PE all money and valuables must be handed in. The school cannot be responsible for items left unattended.
- During exams mobile phones should be kept in lockers, left at home or handed to the Exam Invigilator when entering the exam.
- Smart watches are NOT allowed in school.

Parents wishing to convey messages or contact students during the school day should telephone the main school office (0161 483 3622). The message will be relayed to your child.

Please do not ask your child to break the school rules by making or receiving texts or calls during any part of the school day.
